A message from Cancer Research UK

Charity of the Year 2022/23

Cancer Research UK is incredibly grateful for Vertas Group's continued support and partnership with us, and we cannot thank the team enough for their loyalty and amazing work.

As of September 2023, Vertas Group has raised an amazing £65,743 for Cancer Research UK to date.

The Covid pandemic and the current cost of living crisis has dramatically affected our ability to fund research. As such, the support that we have received from the Vertas Group has never been more needed or valued.

We have loved the creativity involved in this year's fundraising, including a dog walking month in August, a golf day and two second-hand days in September, a bake sale in October and the highly regarded Making the Difference Awards now in November.

Although Vertas Group have put the "fun" in fundraising, there are grave reasons as to why their support is so vital for us – to prevent, diagnose and treat cancer.

Every two minutes, someone in the UK is diagnosed with cancer, and 1 in 2 of us will get cancer in our lifetime.

In East Anglia, we are currently making breakthroughs in the early detection of cancer through Cambridge's Early Detection Programme.

Co-led by Professor Rebecca Fitzgerald and Dr Sarah Bohndiek, the programme supports research teams working on a diverse set of challenges. These range from understanding the origins of cancer, to developing

inexpensive and non-invasive tools to help doctors identify the early signs of the disease.

The programme's research focuses on oesophageal, prostate and blood cancers, which claim the lives of thousands of people each year in the UK. Meanwhile, the programme's social science researchers are exploring the broader psychological, legal and economic implications of early detection strategies on individuals and on society.






